



The yacht has been sailing in the waters of the Drake Passage for many years, and annually spends three months in Antarctica. It is excellently equipped for expedition and tourist adventures thanks to it's safety and comfort construction.





The Ocean Tramp yacht with ketch rigging has a length of 66 feet and offers five cabins, providing comfortable accommodation for 13 people through carefully designed spaces. Its construction allows it to reach speeds of up to 8 knots.

The large foredeck is an excellent space for relaxation and observing nature during sailing. Spacious cabins and ample storage capacity make it ideal for longer expeditions.


